Sharp Honors Late Friend and Community Leader Dan Sain

A college scholarship created for HealthPlus union employees in memory of former HealthPlus Board Member Dan Sain has been established by local businessman Roger Sharp. Sharp owns and operates four Sharp Funeral Home locations in Genesee County.

Sain passed away on July 15, 2004. Sharp and Sain served together on the board of directors for HealthPlus of Michigan. To honor Sain, Sharp established the annual \$2,500 Dan Sain Scholarship Award, for which candidates must be dependents of a HealthPlus union employee.

"Danny was deeply involved with the union, with HealthPlus and with the community," said Sharp. "I can't think of a better way to honor his memory."

Sain had served as president of the Greater Flint UAW CAP Council, chairman of the Bishop Airport Authority, Genesee County Planning Commission and Genesee County Parks and Recreation Commission. He has also been the recipient of the Don Riegle Community Service Award and the Genesee County Bar Association May Day Award.

The first recipient of the Dan Sain Scholarship Award was Amanda Therrian of Burton. Amanda, 18, is entering her sophomore year at Central Michigan University majoring in Political Science. She is pursuing a career in politics. She is the daughter of Beth and Mark Therrian.
